FIRE SAFETY WORKSHOPS

We actively educate children and young people through Fire Safety Awareness Sessions, delivered by our colleagues in schools and at our Oswestry Centre of Excellence.

Aimed at all ages, these sessions provide essential training on fire hazards in the home and the dangers of Carbon Monoxide. This initiative, along with other activities reflecting our ethos, underscores our strong partnership with local schools and colleges.

RESIDENT ENGAGEMENT

It is essential for residents to fully understand the risks of fire and carbon monoxide, as well as the importance of having high-quality alarms. To address this, Aico's Relationship Managers organise and participate in numerous resident engagement days aimed at **families and community** members across the UK.

Engaging with residents is a crucial part of our community efforts. These events are designed to **empower** and **educate** residents and encourage their involvement in a relaxed atmosphere, allowing them to freely ask questions about our alarms.



VOLUNTEERING

Every team member is allocated three days each year for volunteering activities.

To demonstrate our commitment, we have signed both the Climate Pledge and the Zero Carbon Shropshire Pledge. Our goal is to raise awareness of the urgent need for climate action, address decarbonisation challenges, and share practical solutions for a sustainable future.

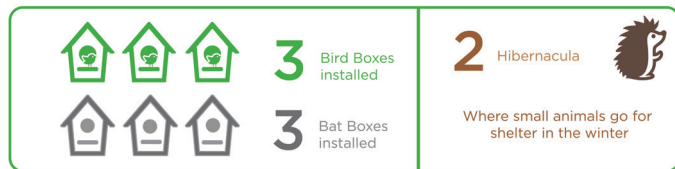
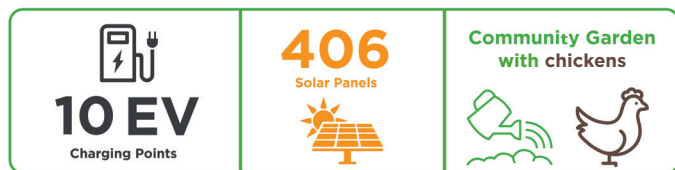

 CARBON OFFSET
COAL EMISSIONS

To highlight our commitment to environmental responsibility, we've achieved a significant milestone in our journey towards carbon neutrality across Scope 1 and 2 emissions, offsetting 331 tonnes of CO₂e generated by these activities in 2024.

This achievement, certified by Carbon Neutral Britain™, represents a crucial step in our broader goal of achieving Net Zero across all Scope 1, 2, and 3 emissions.



Our progress includes a **hybrid** or **full electric** company car policy, in addition to impactful packaging initiatives which eliminate plastic and reduce paper, saving **six to eight tonnes** annually. Furthermore, providing digital instructions via QR codes has cut paper usage by **38 tonnes**. Our eco-fit range within the 3000 Series further **reduces 100% of plastic packaging** by excluding unnecessary components. We are constantly looking to improve, with many exciting sustainability initiatives currently in development.

We have also implemented practical steps at our headquarters, with **four** of our seven acres dedicated to landscaping. A rooftop **solar array** supports our electricity needs, while an attenuation pond and harvesting rainwater minimises surface drainage. Over 2,500 square meters of wildflower meadow have been cultivated to support local pollinators.

OUR FACILITIES



Based at our Headquarters in Oswestry, our Centre of Excellence offers a versatile suite of facilities, including a fully equipped TV studio, a range of meeting rooms, and dedicated demonstration areas – all designed to support collaboration, education, and innovation across the industry.

Since opening in January 2015, the Centre has welcomed hundreds of organisations – from Housing Associations and Local Businesses to Electrical Wholesalers, Distributors, and wider supply chain partners. These events include networking, team-building activities, and specialist training. One key feature of our offering is the City & Guilds-accredited training programme, tailored to upskill professionals across the electrical and energy sectors. These sessions support technical development and foster stronger partnerships across the supply chain.

BREAKOUT ROOM

Equipped with a bespoke integrated AV system including two 75" and one 55" TV screens, this space is ideal for smaller meetings, networking, and refreshment breaks, comfortably seating up to 60 people with dedicated refreshment areas and coffee machines.



WORKSHOP

Seats up to 68 individuals for installation and wiring training. This fully equipped space allows close interaction with our products and hosts many City & Guilds sessions. Notably, it includes a purpose-built smoke chamber for live fire demonstrations, offering an innovative understanding of fire hazards and alarm sensor functionality.





FLEXIBLE MEETING ROOM

Comfortably accommodates up to 40 people and is equipped with presentation facilities, including an interactive smart board, ideal for collaborative workshops, meetings, and training.



EMBER PLACE

A fully furnished mock bungalow fitted with Aico alarms which provides an in-situ demonstration of our products. Featuring a 1960s themed living room, 1990s themed kitchen, and modern bedroom, it clearly illustrates optimal alarm placement and educates visitors on fire and carbon monoxide hazards.

AUDITORIUM

Seating up to 116, perfect for larger presentations and conferences, featuring a 4m projector screen, 4k projector, an AV system, microphones, and electric blinds.



THE CABIN

This unique cabin serves a dual purpose: it's a versatile meeting space and, crucially, a live demonstration of a connected home, featuring our products installed and fully operational in situ.





MOBILE UNITS

Our mobile training and demonstration units extend our reach by bringing our products, technologies, and training directly to customers nationwide. They also facilitate resident engagement days. These units offer a comprehensive overview of Aico's products and solutions to any location across the UK, allowing hands-on experience and access to free educational training sessions.

We proudly offer our Centre of Excellence facilities, free of charge, to local organisations and trusts for their events and meetings.



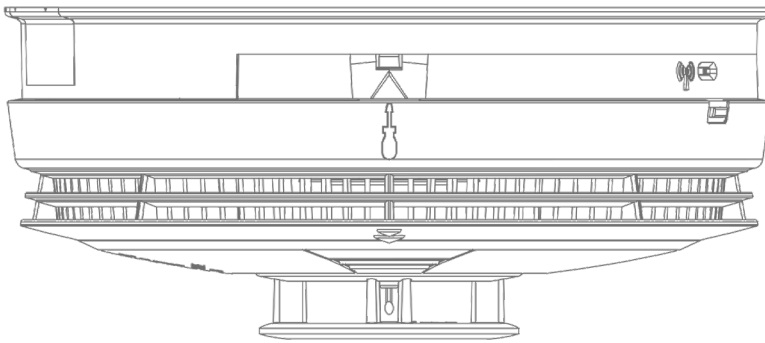
