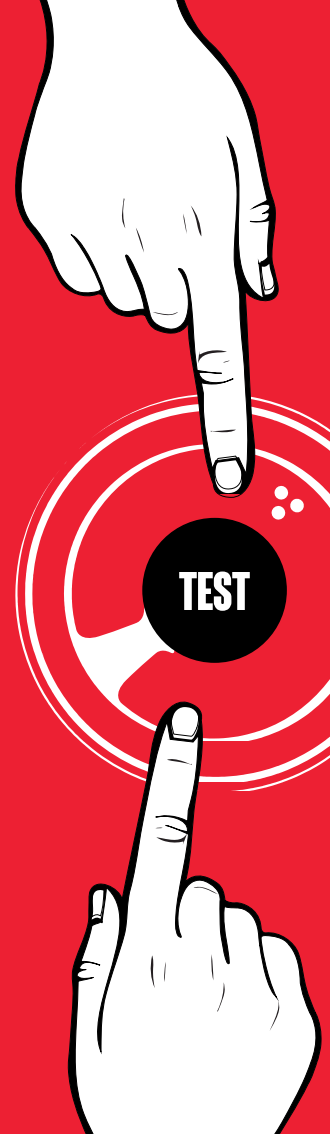

Did you know...

IN SCOTLAND IN 2017/18:

Fires resulted in around 44 deaths and over 1000 injuries.

There were 5,310 reported fires in dwellings (e.g. houses, flats and maisonettes).

ACCORDING TO NATIONAL FIRE STATISTICS:

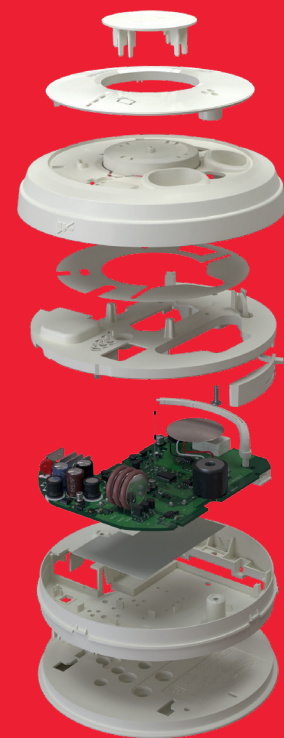
Dwelling fires in which a smoke alarm raised the alarm continue to:

Be discovered more rapidly (less than 5 minutes) after ignition.

Be associated with lower fatal casualty rates.

By February 2022, all homes need to comply with these new standards.



Scotland's New Fire & CO Safety Regulations



Aico's got it covered.

By February 2022, all homes should have:

- Smoke alarms in every circulation space on each storey, such as hallways and landings
- Smoke alarms installed in the room most frequently used for general daytime living purposes
- Heat alarms installed in every kitchen
- All smoke and heat alarms should be interlinked
- **Carbon monoxide alarms to be fitted where there is a fuel burning appliance or a flue**
- This applies to **ALL** homeowners and landlords
