

# What Alarms Do I Have?

## Alarm Identifiers

**Vents** around the outside of the alarm indicates a **smoke** sensor.

A 'turret' on the front of the alarm indicates a **heat** sensor. This is protecting the thermistor underneath.

If your alarm has a carbon monoxide (**CO**) sensor, it will have three small **holes**.



## Product Series



**3000 Series:** Mains-powered with a tamperproof battery and a sheen finish. Three LED lights in a line to the left, and the name of the alarm written at the top.



**140e Series:** Mains-powered with a replaceable battery and a matte finish. A tab on the left of its face to test the alarm, with 'Ei' debossed in the centre.



**600 Series:** Smaller battery-powered alarm with a sheen finish. Plain with no graphic elements.



**200 Series:** Battery-powered. Rectangular shape with rounded sides. All alarms in this series detect CO.
