Who can enter:

Aico's Apprentice of the Year 2026 competition can be entered by an electrical apprentice currently enrolled in an apprenticeship scheme regardless of the stage of their apprenticeship. A representative, like a college or company, may also assist the apprentice with the application. This is open to apprentices UK-wide.

When entries close:

Your entry should be submitted by **Friday 9th, January 2026**.

Each entry will be judged, and a shortlist will be created with the finalists announced on **Friday, 16th January 2026**.

Those who have been successful will be asked to attend the JTL training centre in Birmingham for a practical assessment day with the other successful candidates on **Tuesday, 17th February 2026**.

Each candidate that makes it to this stage will receive a state-of-the-art toolkit packed with all the tools an electrician would need.

Successful candidates concluding this stage will be invited to the Aico Community Awards Ceremony on **Thursday, 16th April 2026**, where the winner will be announced in front of a packed industry audience.

The winner will receive a certificate, a Megger Multifunction tester worth up to £1,200 and industry recognition, celebrating their success. This is a fantastic opportunity for apprentices, employers, and colleges to showcase our current talent in the industry.
